Respiratory Surveillance Report: March 2024



Key Messages

- 1. Cases for COVID-19, Influenza, and RSV declined through March.
- 2. For each case of COVID-19, there are approximately 0.88 new cases (live estimate).1
- 3. For each case of Influenza, there are approximately 1.30 new cases. 2
- 4. For each case of RSV, there are approximately 3 new cases.₃

Respiratory Disease Cases


Week of 2/26/2024 - 3/25/2024

Week of 2/26/2024-3/25/2024






Wastewater Surveillance in Kings County (COVID-19)₄
