
# Respiratory Surveillance Report: January 2024 2/8/2024

## **Key Messages**

- 1. Influenza and RSV cases declined over the month of January while Covid cases remained relatively steady.
- 2. For each case of Covid-19, there are approximately 1.06 new cases.1
- 3. For each case of Influenza, there are approximately 1.30 new cases. 2
- 4. For each case of RSV, there are approximately 3 new cases.3


## **Respiratory Disease Cases**

## 1/1/2024-1/29/2024




