
# Respiratory Surveillance Report: February 2024 3/11/2024

## **Key Messages**

- 1. Cases for COVID-19, Influenza, and RSV declined through February.
- 2. For each case of COVID-19, there are approximately 0.85 new cases (live estimate).1
- 3. For each case of Influenza, there are approximately 1.30 new cases. 2
- 4. For each case of RSV, there are approximately 3 new cases.3



## 1/28/2024-2/25/2024




